A Note from Pastor Matt

Grace and peace to each of you as we make our way into September! School is in full swing, church activities are gearing up, and we truly get to see God at work in this place where we get to be a part of that ministry and service.

One of the questions I get asked quite frequently - especially since the height of the time of COVID-19 - is, 'Pastor... how can we get more people here?'

I'm reminded of this question being asked at a former congregation of mine, where a sweet older lady within the church exclaimed, 'I just don't get it. We're nice. We're open. We're friendly. Why aren't more people coming to see what were about?'

Thankfully, someone else chimed in before I could and said, 'Maybe having the door open isn't enough. Maybe we need to step outside and invite them in.'

And that's genuinely what it's about: sharing what we experience here and inviting others to participate. What would it look like if we shared what we enjoy here at Redeemer with others? You might be surprised at what God can do with a simple invitation to another person.

But I do have a warning, though. Two actually.

But don't get me wrong; change is good. Change, stretching, and the Holy Spirit cause us to change constantly. We get to see the new ways God is directing us to be a community and the kingdom of God because we are open, inviting, and welcoming new people to journey with us.

So, my hope and call for all of us this month (and beyond) is to share the life of ministry here at Redeemer with someone else. Share what you love about this community and where God is at work. There are no strings attached; you just want to share with them what you love about this community and God's work here.

Share this joy that we know here so that others might also know it. Amen!

Redeemer WELCA News - WELCA will not be having its regular meeting in September. Instead, we will be attending the **WELCA Heartland Fall Conference at St. Luke's Lutheran Church in Prosperity Sunday, September 8th at 3pm.** Anyone wanting to attend is asked to contact Anne Caughman.

A total of \$48,700 was collected for the **She Shed Project**. The total cost for the project was \$60,340. SCWELCA raised 62% of that total! The tractor and implements were ordered in July and should arrive in Tanzania by the first week of September. 
